



2025-26 CSNS Predator Finale (8-Ball)

Saturday/Sunday, April 25/26, 2026 (two-day event – final 8 on Sunday)

Registration starts 10am Saturday, Play starts 11am

All qualified players (played in 4 out of 10 Ranking events) will register on the Facebook Finale post or Saturday morning.

This will be an 8-Ball tournament.

Double knockout, no re-draw

A-Side race to 7, B-Side race to 5, Final one race to 8

Note: Tournament officials reserve the right to adjust races based on number of entries.
(There will be no separate women's event)

Fargo under 550 final 8 will play in a separate Single Knock Out race to 5. Fargo under 450 top 8 will race to 4. Top 4 for each event will be paid. These entries come from finale finishers, not rankings.

COST:

Entry Fees staggered based on FARGO RATING:

\$65 + \$5 Green Fee - 630 Fargo rating and above

\$55 + \$5 Green Fee - 575 - 629 Fargo rating

\$45 + \$5 Green Fee - 525 - 574 Fargo rating

\$35 + \$5 Green Fee - 425 - 524 Fargo rating

\$25 + \$5 Green Fee - below 425 Fargo rating

FINALE qualification

Entrance fees for the FINALE will be the same as the Ranking events. All CSNS players must compete in a minimum of 4 Ranking events to qualify for the FINALE. All participants must play the first round of a Ranking event in order to qualify as a tournament towards the FINALE. If a player forfeits or leaves during the first match then the entrance fee is refunded and the tournament will not count towards the FINALE.

Tournament Directors will not take entrance fees if the person has no intention of playing the ranking event. If a player prepays but fails to appear for the event, their fee will be returned to them and they will not be credited as tournament played towards the FINALE requirement.

FINALE format

The FINALE will rotate each year from 9 ball in 2025 then 8 ball in 2026. After this Odd years 9 ball and even years 8 ball.

For 9 ball it will be a Double Knock Out race to 9 on the A side and race to 8 on the B side with the final one race to 13.

For 8 ball it will be a race to 7 on the A side and 5 on the B side with the final race to 8. There will be two Single Knock Out mini tournaments race to 5 for the top 8 players with a Fargo rating between 450-550 and race to 4 for below 450. 1st 2nd and 3rd and 4th place will have payouts, 40%, 30% 15% and 15%. This will start as soon as tables become available.

Tournament Directors reserve the right to lower the races if conditions deem it necessary.
