DRESS CODE

Player's attire must be neat and clean in appearance. No ripped clothing of any kind. Shoes or sneakers must be closed toed. No crocs, flip flops, sandals, slippers, rubber or work boots. Shirts must have sleeves, cover the shoulders, and not display offensive messages. No headphones or earbuds are allowed unless the player has a medical condition. Cell phones must be set to silent. The dress code will be enforced at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

REGISTRATION

Late check in will no longer be tolerated because we need to have the draw completed and match sheets made in order to start on time. Players must have a confirmed response from a director at least 15 minutes prior to the event start time (whatever it is, either 945 for a ranking event or 1045 for a Provincial event). More specifically, you must communicate with a director by phone, text or messenger and they must respond back to you saying that they received the message and you are in the draw. We will be doing the draw 15 minutes prior to the start time. If do not follow this process you will not be in the draw for the event.
